

Greater Cincinnati Earth Coalition Exhibitor/Vendor Code of Conduct

In accordance with the Greater Cincinnati Earth Coalition (GCEC) mission of holding a “community event for not-for-profit organizations, businesses, government agencies, and individuals from the Ohio-Kentucky-Indiana Tri-State region who work cooperatively and actively to promote the beauty and environmental quality of the Tri-State area.” we require that all exhibitors and vendors adhere to the following code of conduct:

1. Respect Summit Park and its employees;
2. Respect fellow exhibitors and vendors, their approved spaces, and their employees;
3. Avoid slanderous or offensive;
4. Provide services in a fair and equitable manner;
5. Ensure that decisions are unprejudiced and unbiased;
6. All vendors and exhibitors are expected to comply with all federal, state, and local ordinances.

Exhibitors/vendors must act with integrity. All participants are expected to demonstrate a commitment to legal, ethical, safe, fair and environmentally responsible practices.

As an exhibitor/vendor of the Greater Cincinnati Earth Day event, we ask that you respect this code of conduct during your use of the Greater Cincinnati Earth Day event space, Summit Park, Blue Ash. Failure to do so will result in being asked to leave the Greater Cincinnati Earth Day event-grounds immediately and may include exclusion from future GCEC events.



The Greater Cincinnati Earth Coalition reserves the right to reject vendor or exhibitor status from the event. GCEC reserves the right to contact law enforcement if any federal, state, or local law/ordinance is violated
